The annual conference of Afghanistan Forum in Deutschland e.V. also aims to help fostering a more inclusive and supportive environment for Afghanistan diaspora in Germany; to bridge the divides and heal the fragmentation that hinders their full participation in the German society.

### Diaspora Collective Interests: Role of civil society organizations

Civil organizations and processes of organizing or self-organization of groups, activities and networks, play vital roles in every society, particularly for diaspora groups. Through organizations, individual interests evolve to collective ones. The interlinkage between factors of self-organizations (language centers, cultural hubs, sports groups, mosques or business centers), can further influence the representation of the concerned groups into the broader social perspectives, either in local advocacy efforts or in national politics.
